English

We begin this half term with the book 'Mini Rabbit Not Lost.' By the end of the unit we will write our own narratives.

Geography: Our Planet, Our World

This project teaches children to locate countries and cities, and use grid references, compass points and latitude and longitude. They learn about the layers of the Earth and plate tectonics and discover the five major climate zones. They learn about significant places in the United Kingdom and carry out fieldwork to discover how land is used in the locality.

Mathematics

During Autumn 1 we will be focusing on place value, counting and mental fluency.

We will be learning new times tables - 3s, 4s and 8s.

French

We will be learning:

Greetings, classroom instructions, phonics and numbers.

Art : Contrast and Complement

This project teaches children about colour theory by studying the colour wheel and colour mixing. It includes an exploration of tertiary colours, warm and cool colours, complementary colours and analogous colours, and how artists use colour in their artwork.
