### **Successes and Sustainability**

Here are some successes from the spending of our PE Premium funding this year, as well as how we will sustain these going forward.

### **Funding clubs for children with pupil premium funding**

Every child in the school has had access to an after school sports club this year. We have paid for attendance at these clubs for children with pupil premium funding. 22 children with pupil premium funding accessed these clubs throughout the year. Next year, we will continue to pay for children with pupil premium funding to access these clubs.

### **Playleaders**

As part of our membership to the North Herts School Sports Partnership, we were able to train some of our Year 5 children to become playleaders. These children have successfully organised and run activities for younger children at playtimes. They also helped to run events at our Sports Morning. These children will continue to be playleaders in Year 6, as well as helping to train new playleaders from the new Year 5 class.

### **Upskilling staff**

We continue to upskill our staff through coaches teaching some PE lessons. Staff are learning new activities and skills through this. This will continue next year.

### **Year 6 Legacy Event**

All of Year 6 took part in the Olympic Legacy event at Knights Templar in June. This allowed the children to compete against children from a variety of schools. The children thoroughly enjoyed this. We will take part in this event (as well as others like tournaments and fixtures) next year too.
